## Step 1: Installing Your iPad into the Keyboard Case

Insert the iPad into the bottom of the case, then push the top section into place until fully secured.

#### Step 2: Turning On/Off the Power Switch

Push the power button to "ON" to turn the device on. Once the device is turned on, the LED indicator will light up for 4s and then turn off.

# Step 3: Establishing Bluetooth Connection

1.Press the "Connect" button. The blue indicator light will flash, indicating that the keyboard's Bluetooth is waiting for pairing.


